# Who are we?

Food for the Soul (F4S) is an outreach of Lighthouse church which exists to provide FREE food to those in need within our community. It runs every 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month alongside her sister outreach Garments of Praise. The mission of F4S is to build relationship and heartfelt connection with those in our community; to meet a physical need in order to also have opportunity to meet a spiritual need. Often, we have prayer tables on site with volunteers who are eager to meet our guests and offer prayer and support.

Food for the Soul is run entirely on volunteer support and donations. One hundred percent of all proceeds raised for F4S go back into the outreach.

Each month we see lives that are touched and even changed because of the care and support that they received at this outreach.





# Easter Pancake Breakfast

On April 1, the Saturday between Good Friday and Resurrection Sunday, Food for the Soul served our community a FREE pancake breakfast at the Lighthouse Church. Over 120 people were in attendance.

Along with their pancakes, guests were also fed the Good News of the Gospel in celebration of Easter. In fact, there was a special live production entitled "A Story About Hope" which featured a cast re-inacting the story of Lazarus' resurrection from the dead [John 11:1-44]. 

# The Outreach House is Under Renovation

For those who may not know, our outreach house is in the process of renovation after flood damage that took place in January 2022. Since then, we have been working to not only repair the damages but also reconstruct the entire house to efficiently function for both our outreaches.

To date, the basement space [which is where our GOP store operates] has undergone a revamp that included removing a wall, installing ship-lap walls for clothes to be hung, new lighting, and an overall fresh and updated look.

The main level which used to be an extended meeting space, is currently being renovated into a kitchen & pantry for F4S to operate from.

Although we were able to renovate much of the space on the insurance claim [as a result of the flood damage], these funds are nearly deplete. We are SO excited to see this project come to completion and to experience the greater impact that will be had in the community as a result of a more functional space!

# Who are we?

The Pilot Program was a pop-up outreach of Lighthouse Church whose mission was to assist students [Grades 1-6] with homework help. This outreach was launched in September 2022 and ran till June 2023 on Thursday evenings from 4:00-6:00pm at the Lighthouse Church.

Interested students from the Spruce Grove/Stony Plain community, could apply to receive an opportunity to receive help with homework. The program was operated by qualified tutors who graciously gifted their time to assist these students. They worked one-on-one with each student, assisting them with their homework and assignments while also providing students and their families with connection to church, encouragement, prayer and relational support.

#### FEEDBACK FROM FAMILIES

- Parents appreciated the academic support and attention given to their children.
- Children's love for learning was stimulated!
- One parent reported that having homework assistance was helpful to the whole family.
- Positive connections to the church were made.
- One family became connected to the GOP outreach as a result of participating in the Pilot Program.

#### The Goal:

To actively demonstrate and share the love of Jesus Christ and the Gospel to the Tri-Region by providing a Spirit-filled space with qualified volunteers to support with homework, and skill development, particularly in areas of literacy and numeracy for students in Grades 1-6.
