PASTOR'S PEN

As we step into the month of May, I want to take a moment to encourage your hearts and remind you that God is actively at work among us. Spring is a season of renewal, what was once dormant begins to come alive again. In the same way, I believe this is a season where God is stirring fresh faith and fresh growth in our lives and in our church.

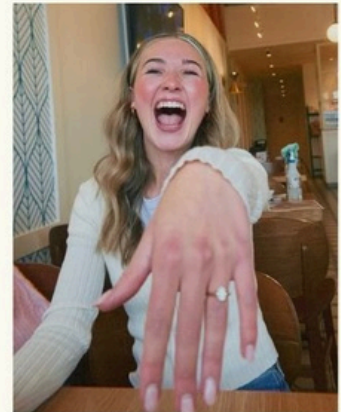

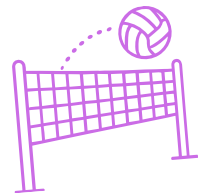

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE GENERAL FUND & DESIGNATED GIVING?

GENERAL FUND: Tithes and general giving go into our General Fund. Our General Fund pays all of our monthly bills and expenses including, operational expenses, payroll, repairs and maintenance, and all expenses related to the church and its operations.

DESIGNATED GIVING: Designated giving is typically where you would designate your offering toward a specific ministry, mission, or fundraising initiative. All funds in designated giving are used to cover expenses within that ministry or mission.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A TITHE AND AN OFFERING?

TITHE: a tithe is one tenth or ten percent. Scripture is clear that the Lord requires we give back to Him ten percent of our wealth or income. [Leviticus 27:30; Proverbs 3:9]

Everything that we have is the Lord's; He asks for one tenth to be given back to Him.

OFFERING: An offering is what you give over and above your ten percent.

Offerings are where you typically direct designated giving to other ministries or missions.

HOW DO I DECIDE WHERE TO DESIGNATE MY GIVING?

First and foremost, when deciding how to designate your giving, we implore you to pray and ask the Lord to direct your giving. However, here is some helpful information you can use while discerning your allocations.

Here at the Kingdom Advance Church, we use a financial structure which is best interpreted by the diagram to the left. Once an offering is designated, it cannot be used for any other purpose than that of its designation (unless the donor's permission is given). Therefore, when you give to the General Fund, it gives freedom to our stewards to use the funds not only to cover the operational costs, but to then allocate the “surplus” toward vision projects (such as future hires, renovations, upgrades, missions, etc.).
